INTERNATIONAL FORUM ON HPV AND HEAD & NECK CANCER

This forum, part of the EUROGIN 2015 congress, includes dedicated sessions extending over 3 days on HPV infection and head & neck cancers.

Oropharyngeal cancer is one of the fastest rising cancers in many countries. This has been attributed to the rise of HPV associated head and neck cancers. This new disease entity appears to have significantly better survival outcomes. However, important questions arise regarding its natural history, diagnosis, patient counseling and the best management regimens.
